

PUBLIC NOTICE 1-2019/PROPPG ADMISSION OF VISITING PROFESSOR 2019 SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION OF VISITING PROFESSORS

The Federal Rural University of the Semi-arid Region (UFERSA), through the Office of the Vicepresident for Research and Graduate Studies, in exercise of its legal and statutory duties, to strengthen the institutional Graduate Programs (Masterøs and Doctorate) and research groups, announces the call for applications in the simplified selection process for the admission of Brazilian or foreign VISITING PROFESSORS, in accordance with the Law n°. 8,745, of December 9th, 1993, amended by Laws n°. 9,849/99 and n°. 10,667/03 and the Decree n°. 7,485, of May 18th, 2011, the Law 12,722, of December 28th, 2012, and Decree 8,259, of May 30th, 2014.

1. Objectives of the admission

1.1. To enable Brazilian or foreign researchers of recognized competence and leadership to work temporarily in Graduate Programs at UFERSA and, thus, contribute to the consolidation and internationalization process of these programs. It will be especially encouraged the application of proposals with at least one of the following characteristics:

a) proposals aimed at strengthening research lines of a Masterøs program in order to result in a concrete proposal for the creation of a Doctoral program;

b) proposals which represent the possibility of starting or consolidating a knowledge area considered priority by the Graduate Program the researcher is applying for;

c) proposals which contribute to the development and consolidation of the internationalization process of Graduate Programs (Masterøs and Doctorate) through the establishment of partnerships and agreements with foreign researchers and institutions.



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2. Number of vacancies and duration of contract

2.1 There are a total of 10 (ten) vacancies (see Annex I).

2.2 The contract may have the duration of:

a) For Brazilian applicants: 12 (twelve) months and may be renewed, provided that the duration of the contract does not exceed 24 (twenty-four) months;

b) For foreign applicants: 24 (twenty-four) months and may be renewed, provided that the duration of the contract does not exceed 48 (forty-eight) months.

3. Application requirements

3.1 To apply for the aforementioned vacancies of Visiting Professor, Brazilian or foreign applicants must meet the following requirements:

a) Fit into one of the following categories:

- Senior Visiting Professor

The applicant must hold a Doctoral degree for at least 10 years and have high-impact scientific production. It is preferable that applicants have similar profile to a CNPq Research Productivity Scholar, level 1, in the same knowledge area the Graduate Program is evaluated by CNPq (Criteria for CNPq Research Productivity Scholarship);

- Junior Visiting Professor

The applicant must hold a Doctoral degree for at least 03 years and have high-impact scientific production. It is preferable that applicants have similar profile to a CNPq Research Productivity Scholar, level 2, in the same knowledge area the Graduate Program is evaluated by CNPq (Criteria for CNPq Research Productivity Scholarship);

b) Not have accumulation of positions;



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c) Not have been hired in the last 24 (twenty-four) months, based on Law 8,745 of December 9th, 1993;

d) Not be a direct or indirect employee of the Brazilian Federal Government, States and Municipalities, as well as employee or server of their subsidiary and controlled companies, according to the sixth article of Law 8,745/93;

e) Be fluent in Spanish or English, in case of foreign applicants;

f) Upon registration, applicants must choose one category to apply for. The ones who apply for **Senior Visiting Professor** shall be evaluated first and, if there are not applications or even approved applicants for this category, then the ones who apply for **Junior Visiting Professor** shall be evaluated.

4. Required documentation

- 4.1 The applicant must present the following documentation:
 - a) Application form to be filled in on the website of the Office of the Vice-president for Research and Graduate Studies (PROPPG).
 - b) Work plan with the following information:
 - i. Academic activities to be delivered in the Graduate Program (courses, advising, research project and others);
 - ii. Research project to be developed in the same knowledge area of the Graduate Program;
 - iii. Relevance of the proposal to Graduate Program factors evaluated by CAPES in order to create Doctoral Programs and promote internationalization/innovation, respectively, in Graduate Programs graded 3 and the ones graded 4, 5 and 6 by CAPES;
 - iv. Goals to be reached and the performance indicators of scientific production, human resources development, partnerships and agreements with national and international excellence groups, strengthening of innovative research lines, and other academic facts to achieve an excellence program;

c) Updated Curriculum vitae from CNPq Lattes Platform, highlighting the intellectual production in the last the five (5) years and score table (**Annex III**). In case of foreign applicants, the curriculum must be prepared according to the score table (**Annex III**);



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d) Doctoral diploma or certificate of completion in accordance with the specification of the vacancy offered by the Graduate Program;

e) Photocopy of ID card, Individual Taxpayer Registration Card (CPF, acronym in Portuguese) and proof of address for Brazilian applicants;

f) Photocopy of the passport for foreign applicants. The contract of Visiting Professor is conditional to the work permit issuance by the Ministry of Labor and Employment, and to the visa issuance by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

5. Submission of required documentation

The applications must be forwarded only electronically by filling in and sending the application form on PROPPG website, from January 11th to February 11th 2019. The applications will only be accepted if forwarded via e-mail until 11:59PM of February 11th, 2019 (Brasília time).

6. The selection procedure

6.1 The proposals will be analyzed by an Examining Committee composed of experts designated by the Vice-president for Research and Graduate Studies;

6.2 The Committee will assign scores from 0 (zero) to 100 (one hundred) to each proposal. The applicant who does not score a minimum of 50 will be unclassified in this selection process, which will take the following aspects into account:

- a) Impact of the proposal ó 30 scores;
- I. For Graduate Programs graded 3 by CAPES: the impact of the proposal for the strengthening of a Masterøs Program and its contribution to scientific production indicators of the program;



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II. For Graduate Programs graded 4, 5 or 6 by CAPES: the impact of the proposal for research, internationalization and innovation processes assessed according to the goals and indicators mentioned in the work plan.

b) Consistency between the chosen category of Visiting Professor, the work plan, and the research project submitted ó 20 scores;

c) Scientific production in the last 5 (five) years and its relation with the Visiting Professorøs profile according to the vacancy offered by the Graduate Program ó 30 scores;
d) Priority is given to proposals within the framework of institutional efforts to include, in an integrated way, different Graduate Programs or strategies for UFERSA groups to cowork with international excellence groups ó 20 scores.

7. The Working regime and Compensation

7.1 The hired Visiting Professor will be subject to a weekly 40-hour working regime with full-time dedication;

7.2 The Senior Visiting Professor's compensation will be composed of the base salary, established for level 1 of Class A - *Associado A* of the Brazilian professorship in higher education, plus the remuneration for the Doctoral Degree, plus meals allowance, in accordance with the working regime established herein, and the provisions in Law n^o. 12,772, of December 28th, 2012, published in the Federal Official Gazette (DOU, acronym in Portuguese) of December 31st, 2012, and Normative Guideline SRH/MP n^o. 5 of October 28th, 2009: R\$ 16,199.24 (effective from August 1st, 2018).

7.3 The Junior Visiting Professor's compensation will be composed of the base salary, established for level 1 of Class A - *Adjunto A* of the Brazilian professorship in higher education, plus the remuneration for the Doctoral Degree, plus meals allowance, in accordance with the working regime established herein, and the provisions in Law n° . 12,772, of December 28th, 2012, published



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in the Federal Official Gazette (DOU) of December 31st, 2012, and Normative Guideline SRH/MP n^o. 5 of October 28th, 2009: R\$ 11,561.91 (effective from August 1st, 2018).

9. Final results

The final results of this selection process will be announced until March 1st, 2019 on the PROPPG website, after the documents submitted by the applicants are analyzed;

9.1 It will be the responsibility of PROPPG and the Postgraduate Collegiate Board to approve the final results of this Simplified Selection Process, which will be published in the Federal Official Gazette;

9.2 This Public Notice may be canceled or amended, in part or in whole, at any time, once the supervening reasons so determine, without thereby implying in the generation of rights or obligations with respect to the interested parties;

9.3 In case of a tie among applicants, Paragraph 2 of Article 329 of the General Rules of UFERSA must be respected;



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9.4 The appeals must be filed according to the aforementioned schedule;

9.5 The appeal must be filed only via e-mail (proppg@ufersa.edu.br).

10. Contract renewal

10.1 The employment contract may be renewed once, since the request is filed by the related Graduate Program and received at PROPPG at least 60 (sixty) days prior to the termination of the contract;

10.2 The Graduate Program must attach the following documents to the request:

a) minutes of approval by the related Collegiate Board, containing the duration of the contract;

b) updated work plan for the upcoming period (in case of renewal), according to item (ii) of topic 4.1(b) hereof;

c) Visiting Professor's curriculum in CNPq Lattes format;

d) technical and scientific report of the research activities performed during the contracting period;

e) photocopy of proof of address, in case of Brazilian applicants, in case of address change;

f) photocopy of the passport and mailing address in Brazil, in case of foreign applicants.

11. Final Provisions

11.1 Amendments to the contract must be requested, with a justifying statement, by the interested party to the Office of the Vice-president for Personnel Management (PROGEPE). The Office of the Vice-president for Personnel Management will analyze the possibility of implementation, in respect to the current legislation;

11.2 Applicants who have already been hired under Law 8,745/93 may be rehired, since they have already completed 24 (twenty-four) months of termination of the previous contract;

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11.3 The admission of Visiting Professor must be in accordance with the Law 8.745/93, and the application implies in the commitment of the applicant to accept the conditions established in this selection process;

11.4 It is the responsibility of the foreign Visiting Professor to take the necessary steps to obtain the entry visa in Brazil, in the category corresponding to the activities that will be developed, with validity compatible with the period of stay in Brazil, including the possibility of extension of the contract, in accordance with current legislation;

11.5 The Visiting Professor may not receive assignments, functions or charges not provided for in the contract, nor may the applicant be appointed or designated, even if precarily or in substitution, to hold a position of trust (Art. 9, subsection I and II of Law No. 8,745/93);

11.6 This Simplified Selection Process will expire within 1 (one) year, from the publication date of the approval of the results in the Federal Official Gazette;

11.7 Omitted cases herein will be resolved by the Office of the Vice-president for Research and Graduate Studies.
